# Income Fund II

#### **E CLASS INCOME SHARES**

#### **Fund Description**

The primary investment objective of the Fund is to seek high current income, consistent with prudent investment management. Long-term capital appreciation is a secondary objective.

The Income Fund II is a portfolio that is actively managed and utilizes a broad range of fixed income securities that seek to produce an attractive level of income while maintaining a relatively low risk profile, with a secondary goal of capital appreciation.

- This fund seeks to meet the needs of investors who are targeting a competitive and consistent level of income without compromising long term capital appreciation.
- The fund seeks to generate a competitive monthly dividend while also maintaining a focus on the total return objective.
- The fund aims to achieve this by employing PIMCO's best incomegenerating ideas across global fixed income sectors with an explicit mandate on risk-factor diversification.
- The fund offers daily liquidity.

The Fund may use or invest in financial derivatives.

This fund is designed for investors who seek steady income: it takes a broadbased approach to investing in income-generating bonds. The fund taps into multiple areas of the global bond market, and employs PIMCO's vast analytical capabilities and sector expertise to help temper the risks of high income investing. This approach seeks to provide consistent income over the long term.

#### ABOUT THE BENCHMARK

Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Index represents securities that are SECregistered, taxable, and dollar denominated. The index covers the U.S. investment grade fixed rate bond market, with index components for government and corporate securities, mortgage pass-through securities, and asset-backed securities. 



Sector Allocation (Duration in Years)








